SCAN TO ACCESS YOUR MANUAL

Before conducting any maintenance procedures, make sure you are wearing proper safety equipment and the machine is disconnected from power. *Refer to Service Manual for precise schedule WEEKLY RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE Inspect the wheels and blade holder for damage Check that all screws are tight and secure Remove any glue, mastic, and debris from wheels, blade holder, and machine. Manually turn the angle adjustment wheel clockwise and counterclockwise to assure the machine raises and lowers the rear wheels Check for misaligned, binding of moving parts, broken parts and any other conditions that may affect operation. Make sure the T-Handle wrench that came with the machine is in the holder located on the left side of the machine near the adjustment knob. **QUARTERLY RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE*** Inspect handle grips for wear and replace if necessary. Check two Allen bolts that secure blade holder cover for wear and replace periodically. Inspect rear kick plate and remove any debris build-up. Check the blade holder for signs of wear, cracks, or other damage. Replace if necessary. Check rear wheels for damage and excessive wear. Check and grease angle adjustment wheel and threads to ensure they turn freely and the machine raises and Make sure the power switch is in the off position before plugging in the 550. Turn the machine on and off to verify that the on/off switch is working properly. **BI-ANNUALLY RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE*** Inspect/replace cutter head bearing. **

Inspect/replace the four isolators. **
