

## RENTAL IN/OUT CHECKLIST

Made in America Since 1968





Each time the 550 is rented out and returned, follow these steps to ensure it is in proper working condition.

Before conducting any maintenance procedures, make sure you are wearing proper safety equipment and the machine is disconnected from power.

\*Refer to Service Manual for precise schedule

Make sure the cord from the power box to the motor is connected and in good working condition.
Make sure the power switch is in the off position before plugging in the 550.
Plug the unit in and test the on/off switch to make sure it is functioning properly.
Make sure the T-Handle wrench that came with the machine is in the holder located on the left side of the machine near the height adjustment knob.
Make sure the black T-Bolts that secure the handle are in place and tight.
Remove any glue, mastic, and debris from the wheels and blade holder.
<ul> <li>Look for damage to the blade holder.</li> <li>Manually turn the angle adjustment wheel clockwise and counterclockwise to ensure the machine raises and lowers the rear wheels.</li> </ul>
Make sure the thumb screws that hold the front weight are in place and tight.
All maintenance, nameplates and safety stickers must be in place and legible.
Make sure the operator's manual and safety glasses are with the machine.
Check that the power cord is free of damage.
Check for misaligned, binding of moving parts, broken parts and any other conditions that may affect operation.
