SCAN TO ACCESS YOUR MANUAL Before conducting any maintenance procedures, make sure you are wearing proper safety equipment and the machine is disconnected from power.

W	EEKLY RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE
	Inspect the wheels and blade holder for damage
	Make sure the power cord on the operator's handle is
	in good, working condition
	Plug the unit in and ensure the on/off switch is
	functioning properly. When the unit is powered on,
	push the two control levers forward and the 6280HD will move forward.
	Pull the two control levers backwards to reverse the unit.
	Ensure the axle pins are secured in the wheel hub hole (Remove the axle pins for easier maneuverability when not powered)
	Make sure the T-Handle wrench that came with the machine is in the holder located directly below the
	right hand grip towards the middle of the handle.
	Remove any glue, mastic, and debris from the wheels,
_	debris deflector, front weight, and blade holder plate.
	Look for damage to the blade holder
	Check the quick adjustment multi-position handle to
	ensure it moves freely and locks into place
	Make sure the wheel cleaner touches, but does not dig

## **BI-ANNUALLY RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE\***

- ☐ Inspect handle grips for wear and replace if necessary
  ☐ Check blade holder bolts for wear and replace periodically
  ☐ Check the blade holder for signs of wear, cracks, or other damage. Replace if necessary
- Check the rear wheels for damage and excessive wear
- Inspect/replace cutting head bearing.\*\*
  Inspect/replace the isolators.\*\*
  - Remove and replace 1.5 gallons of Texaco Rando 46
    Hydraulic Oil
